CAREER HISTORY:

Brixton O2 Academy (September 2024 to Present)

Brixton O2 Academy is a live music venue with a 5000 capacity.

- Employed when moved to London for bar work and box office.

CAPE (January 2023 – September 2024)

CAPE is an after-school facility for children linked to Birkenhead High School Academy, Wirral.

- Worked as a playworker with pre-school and SEN children after school to extend their development.
- Took several qualifications to support the children with their specific needs.

WEB Choir (September 2023 – September 2024)

WEB Merseyside is a community based service that supports women, girls, men and boys with complex needs funded and supported by Wirral Council and Birkenhead Sings

- Co ran a fun choir for women once a week to build confidence and self esteem and performed with them at several venues across the Wirral to raise money for charity

Bar Work (January 2023 - December 2023)

- Worked at two bars at weekends serving drinks and food

Events 471 (October 2022 - October 2023)

Events 471 is an event management company based and formed on the Wirral which specialises in promoting live music events and supporting local talent

- Ran Box office and booked acts for live events in Wirral and Liverpool

Future Yard (January 2021 - December 2023)

Future Yard is a Live Music Venue providing live industry training and a regional hub for artist Development, Box Office, Event management, artist liaison

- Secured a free place on their Soundcheck Programme - Designed to introduce young people to the skills they need to pursue careers in the live music industry.
- Following on from this programme I was offered paid work across various different functions including event management, artist liaison and box office
- I also ran Mosh Tots every Sunday morning at the venue - Aimed at children aged 1-8, Mosh Tots aims to introduce young people to live music in a safe and fun environment.

Thornton Hall Hotel (October 2020 - March 2021)

- Responsibilities included serving drinks and food at weekends and working at key events such as weddings, proms, anniversaries etc

Food Festivals/Events (Summer 2022 and 2023)

- Worked for a couple of brands (Gifflar Swedish Cinnamon Rolls and Godminster Cheese) at Food Festivals during two Summers (including Taste of London) - Sampling, marketing and selling.

PERFORMANCE EXPERIENCE

ACM Showcase

- I auditioned, along with over 100 people and was one of 10 people selected to perform at the ACM Showcase event with Natalie Weiss (Nov 2024).

Royal Liverpool Philharmonic

- I sang as part of the Liverpool Philharmonic Youth Session Orchestra for four years, performing solo, in groups and supporting LIMF Academy (Award winning initiative dedicated to enhancing the creative and professional skills of young, aspiring music creators based in Merseyside). I also did my work experience there learning all the different functions required for putting on a live event.

- Performed at various events in the North West as part of Sense of Sound Singers.

Floral Pavilion

- Auditioned for and performed at the first Sunday Night Live event at the Floral Pavilion hosted by Shirley Ballas.

Liverpool Anglican Cathedral

- Performed for 4 years as part of the Gilbert Scott Singers at Liverpool Anglican Cathedral. I was also responsible for promotion of the choir on social media platforms.

Wirral SOUP at Future Yard

- I was fortunate to be selected to sing at Wirral SOUP's first event - Wirral SOUP is a volunteer led, non - profit group raising money for local projects being run by local people across Wirral.

Events 471

- Was asked to perform live with 3 other aspiring performers at Mollys Chambers Wirral.

Choirs

- I have been part of several choirs since the age of 11 performing at events for charity across the North West.
- Performed solo and as part of a singing group to raise money for various charities – Asthma & Lung Association, Dementia, Autism Together, various Cancer charities and Parkinsons PSP. Also performed in local hospitals for terminally ill patients.
