سعد الغفرى SAAD AL GHEFARI

born in Damascus 1981, is an actor and stand-up comedian based in Vienna. Growing up in a family of female artists, he was raised up in between emancipatory discussions about religion, politics, art and women's rights, significantly influenced by his grandmother and his mother, who, as prominent figures in the Syrian cultural scene, have always been committed to socio-political issues. At the age of nine, Al Ghefari began his career as a child actor in Syrian television, followed by numerous film, theater abnd television productions both in Syria and abroad. He completed his studies at the renowned Higher Institute of Dramatic Arts in Damascus. Over time, Al Ghefari developed a particular interest in comedy as both an artistic form and a political tool. This interest deepened during the Syrian War, where he explored the potential of comedy as a means of expression. He performed as a stand-up comedian in Damascus for the first time in 2014, establishing a genre that had not previously existed in Syria. After his flight from the ongoing war in Syria, he continued his work as a stand-up comedian in Austria, trying to develop a language that is both idiosyncratic and global, preserving the polemics and poetics of the Arabic language in English with all its deviations and absurdities. Along with his passion for crosscultural conceptions of history, mythology and etymology, he is keen to display these traditions through new media such as the Tiktok platform, following their potential to engage youth as a movement for a global understanding to come.

Currently, he is working on the play *I'm Crocodiled*, in collaboration with Theater Spektakel funded by Stadt Wien, and is teaching in the project *Schalom und Salam - Scenes of Peace*, a political education initiative aimed at promoting Jewish-Arab dialogue.
